BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF CHRISTIAN COUNTY,
STATE OF MISSOURI, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

"WATER WATCH WEEK" JUNE 11 THROUGH JUNE 21, 2011

WHEREAS, the rivers, lakes, springs and streams of the Ozarks region are among its most distinctive and distinguishing characteristics, and

WHEREAS, these water resources have attracted people to settle in the Ozarks and continue to support the economic prosperity and development of the region; and

WHEREAS, these water resources contribute immeasurably to the attractive outdoor lifestyle of the region and continue to draw visitors who are an important part of our economic base, and

WHEREAS, the rivers, lakes, springs and streams of the Ozarks constitute a precious resource to be conserved and sustained for coming generations;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri is pleased to endorse the programs and activities sponsored by regional watershed organizations known as "Water Watch Week" from June 11 through June 21, 2011, whose purpose is to publicize the importance of water quality in our regional watersheds, to promote wider awareness of the challenges in keeping our rivers, lakes and streams clean, and to engage more citizens in efforts to sustain high water quality.

Further resolved that the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri expresses its appreciation to the nonprofit watershed organizations including the James River Basin Partnership, the Watershed Committee of the Ozarks, Table Rock Lake Water Quality and the Upper White River Basin Foundation (Ozarks Water Watch) which provide continuing leadership for water quality in the region.
