**WHEREAS**, 33% of hospital emergency room visits by children are for treatment of head injuries, and



3. Enlisting the assistance of media outlets to promote the safety program of wearing helmets while bicycling.


**RESOLVED**, that the Christian County Commission hereby adopts this resolution the 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 2008.



American Children's Safety Network Resolution July 31, 2008


