## **RESOLUTION NO.**

## A RESOLUTION OF CHRISTIAN COUNTY, MISSOURI ELECTING CHRISTIAN COUNTY TO REMAIN AS A COUNTY OF THE SECOND CLASSIFICATION UNTIL THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF THE COUNTY IS SUCH AS TO PLACE IT IN ANOTHER CLASSIFICATION

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Christian County, Missouri is currently a second class county pursuant to Missouri law, and;

WHEREAS, the assessed valuation of Christian County has surpassed the sum of six hundred million dollars and has maintained such assessed valuation for at least five years, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 48.020 RSMo, Christian County may elect either (1.) to remain a county of the second classification, OR (2.) to be in the first classification as of January 1, 2011.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri, as follows:

1. That, the undersigned County Commission, does hereby elect to remain classified as a county of the second classification until such time as the assessed valuation of the county shall place it into another classification.

2. That this election is made pursuant to the terms of Section 48.020 RSMo as enacted by the Missouri State Legislature in 2010.

3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.
