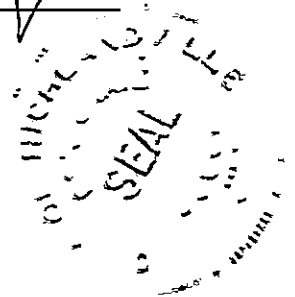
## NOTICE OF ELECTION

**PROCLAMATION OF THE  
CITY OF HIGHLANDVILLE**

This Proclamation was duly passed by the City Council, City of Highlandville, Christian County, Missouri at the council meeting on the 13<sup>th</sup> Day of April, 2010.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City of Highlandville, by its Ordinance No. 149 did authorize an election for the purpose of imposing a sales tax for transportation purposes to be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, said election was duly published and held on April 6, 2010, and,

WHEREAS, said election did result in a tie vote as Certified by the Christian County Clerk following said election, and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 115 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri provides for a special election to be held in the event of tie votes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED AS FOLLOWS:


1. Highlandville City Council has and by this proclamation now does order that a special election be held on Tuesday, the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010.

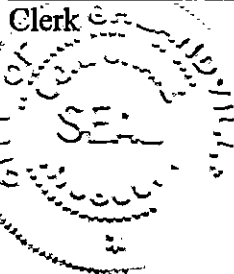
2. The special election shall be for the sales tax issue only. The ballot shall be as follows:


