<u>PETITION TO CONTEST PRIMARY ELECTION</u> (SECTION 115.531 et. seq. RSMo).

COMES NOW Plaintiff and for his Petition states and avers as follows:

1. That Plaintiff is a contestant in the primary election held in Christian County, Missouri on August 5, 2008 for the office of Associate County Commissioner for the Eastern District of Christian County.

2. That Defendant Kay Brown is the County Clerk and the election authority for said primary election pursuant to Section 115.015 RSMo.

3. That Defendant Tom Huff is the purported winner by eleven (11) votes out of approximately 4, 535 votes cast for the office as defined in Section 115.601 RSMo.

4. By virtue of the purported defeat of Plaintiff by Defendant Huff, Plaintiff shall have the right to a recount of all votes cast in the August 5, 2008 election for the office of Eastern Commissioner (Section 115.061 RSMo).

6. Plaintiff further requests that a preliminary hearing be held within five (5) days on the issues presented herein from the date of the filing of this petition in accordance with the provisions of Section 115.531 RSMo.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays the Court to Order a recount by hand of all votes cast in the August 5, 2008 Christian County primary election for Associate Commissioner for the Eastern District, to enter Judgment in accordance with the election recount results and for such other and further relief as the Court shall find is just and appropriate.
