ROAD STRIPING PRESENTATION

Dennis Depriest President of Metro Polymer Labs, Inc. came before the Commission and presented his products used for striping roads and highways.

HOPEDALE HEIGHTS - BARRIERS

A number of Hopedale Heights residents met with the Commission to discuss their options concerning the commercial businesses going up around their addition. Steve Horton Ozark City Administrator, was in attendance as was Ozark Special Road District, Bill Kisse. Many of the concerns and questions were answered by Steve Horton on regulations for a 3rd Class County, regarding barriers associated with residential and commercial areas.

ROZELL ENGINEERING CO. - McCALLEY ROAD

Wayne Diebold of Rozell Engineering Company came before the Commission asking permission to cross McCalley Road and North Farm Road and the question of if they can cut or need to bore. The Commission indicated the company would have to bore.

IAN MARTIN - JAIL NEEDS

Ian Martin head jailer for Christian County, met with the Commission to discuss numerous items concerning the jail. Some of the items discussed were needs of the jail such as, out of date electrical wiring and equipment, air-conditioning being unreliable, more transporters for the medical needs of prisoner, safety covers for ceiling lights in the cells, and personnel for 24 hour suicide watch. The Commission gave permission for a metal door to be purchased out of maintenance budget, and re-do an existing door to create an area for attorneys and their clients. The Commission told Mr. Martin they would do what they could on jail needs, and will get back with him later.

ORDINANCE #96-06-28-1 - RIVER ACCESS

Eastern Commissioner, Tom Chudomelka moved to adopt Ordinance #96-06-28-1, it was seconded by Bill Barnett, and approved unanimously by the Commission. The ordinance states "The Christian County Commission hereby resolves that river access at Linden Lure, off canyon road, be closed after 10:00pm at night and reopened at 8:00am hereafter".
