ORDER

WHEREAS, at an election held April 6, 1993 in Christian County, Missouri the proposition to incorporate the City of Highlandville, Missouri was submitted to the qualified voters in the area proposed to be incorporated, and the result was 143 in favor of incorporation and 70 opposed to incorporation, and as a result the proposition carried.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. That the City of Highlandville is hereby declared by the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri to be incorporated as a city of the fourth class, the name of which is "The City of Highlandville, Missouri."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the metes and bounds description of said city be as is set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri that the following persons shall serve in the offices set opposite their names as officers of said city until the next municipal election and until their successors shall be city qualified and elected.

ORDER

Now on this 8 day of Feb, 1993 the Petition for incorporation of the City of Highlandville is taken up and considered by the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri. Whereupon, the County Commission of Christian County, Missouri finds that all the facts and matters stated and alleged in said Petition are true. The Commission further finds that said Petition was signed by at least 15 percent of the number of votes cast in the last gubernatorial election in the area proposed to be annexed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the issue of whether or not to incorporate said area proposed to be annexed be submitted to the qualified voters of the area proposed to be annexed at the election to be held in the County on April 6, 1993.

3.030. QUALIFICATIONS OF ALDERMEN.

No person shall be an alderman unless he be at least twenty-one years of age, a citizen of the United States, and an inhabitant and resident of the City for one year next preceding his election, and a resident of the ward from which he is elected.

## CHAPTER 3 - ADMINISTRATION

## 3.010 DIVISION OF CITY INTO TWO WARDS.

The City of Highlandville, Missouri shall be divided into two wards and voting precincts known as "Ward One" and "Ward two" described as follows:

(a) Ward One shall be all that part of the City of Highlandville, Missouri described as follows:

All of Highlandville South of EE-8 and East of Highway 160 and includes:

1. All of Section 19, Range 21 West, Township 26 North.
2. West 1/2 of Section 30, Range 21 West, Township 26 North.
3. N.W. 1/4 Section 31, Range 21 West, Township 26 North.

(b) Ward Two shall be all that part of the City of Highlandville, Missouri not covered by Ward One described as follows:

1. West 1/2 of Section 7, Range 21 West, Township 26 North.
2. All of Section 18, Range 21 West, Township 26 North.
3. All of Section 24, Range 22 West, Township 26 North.
4. North 3/4 of Section 25, Range 22 West, Township 26 North.

## 3.020. ELECTIVE OFFICERS - TERMS.

The Mayor shall be elected by the qualified voters of the City for a term of two years and until a successor for the office is elected and qualified. The Mayor shall be elected at the municipal election to be held in the City on the first Tuesday in April of each odd numbered year.

The Board of Aldermen shall be composed of six members, three of which shall be residents from Ward One and three of which shall be residents from Ward Two of the City. Each Alderman shall be residents from Ward Two of the City. Each Alderman shall serve a term of two years and until a successor is elected and qualified. Each Alderman holding office within Ward One and Ward Two of the City shall serve the remainder of the term of his office until his successor is elected and qualified. The terms of office for the Board of Aldermen shall be staggered so that at the municipal election to be held in the City on the first Tuesday in April of each year at least one alderman shall be elected from each ward.

N.W. 1/4 Section 31, Range 21 West, Township 26 North.

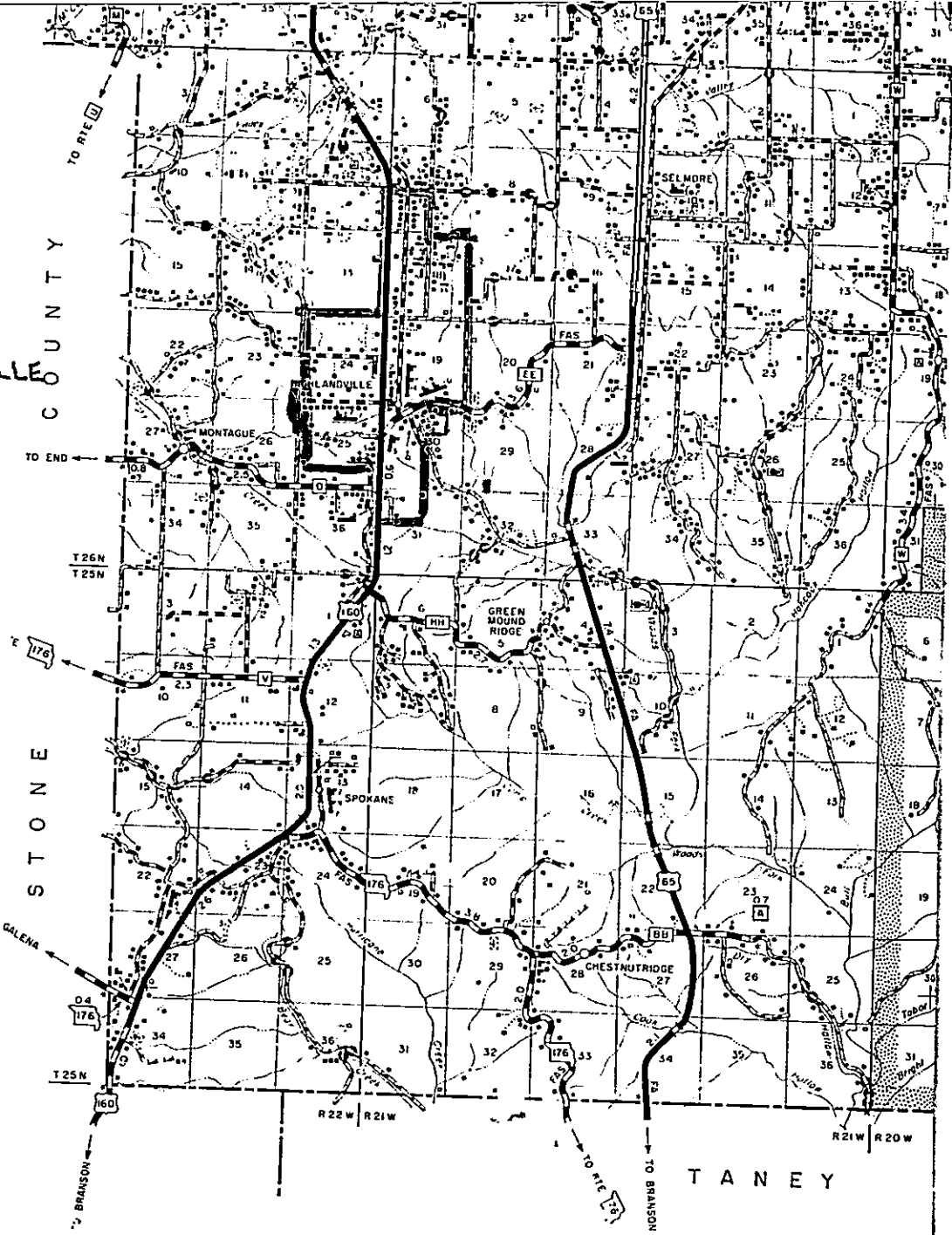
